

BLUE RIBBON REQUIREMENTS

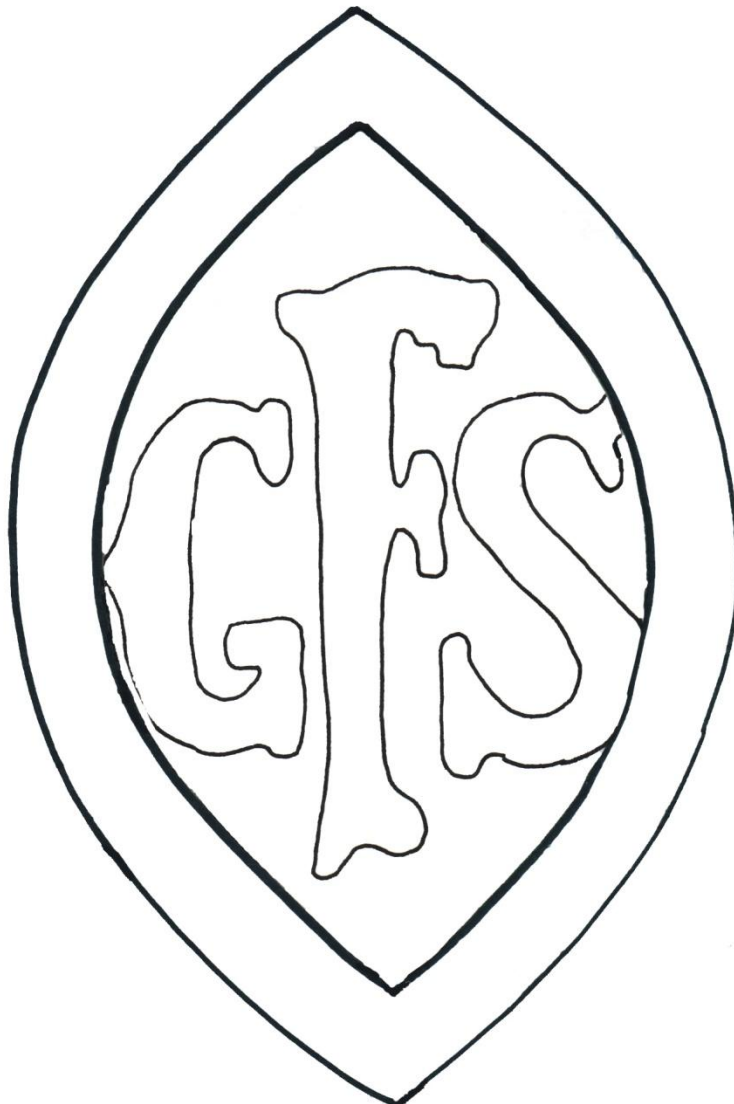
Here's a list of things you need to do to earn the Blue ribbon.
